#### Procedure for awarding Marks for Internal and End Semester Assessments for students admitted from the academic year 2025-26 onwards:

For all the theory courses, practical courses, theory courses with practical component and project work the internal and external assessment marks shall be awarded as per the procedure given below:

#### For Theory Courses (Both UG/PG)

**Internal - 40, End Semester – 60**

**Passing Conditions: 45% in End Semester & 50% in Total marks**

**Note:** End semester examination shall be conducted for 100 marks for a duration of 3 hrs. However, for theory course with 1 credit, End semester examination shall be conducted for 50 marks with a maximum duration of 90 minutes.

#### For Practical Courses (Both UG/PG)

**Internal - 60, End Semester – 40**

**Passing Conditions: 45% in End Semester & 50% in Total marks**

#### For Theory Cum Practical Courses (Both UG/PG)

**Internal - 50, End Sem - 50**

**Passing Conditions:**

- (i) 45% in both End Semester Theory and in End Semester Practical
- (ii) 50% in Theory (Internal Theory + End Semester Theory)
- (iii) 50% in Practical (Internal Practical + End Semester Practical)

**Even if one of these do not satisfy, the Result will be FAIL**
